- 2 Any noise produced or associated with the regulated entertainment shall not cause annoyance to or give reasonable cause for complaint by the occupier of any nearby property. In addition to this, all doors and windows shall be kept closed after 23.00 hours.
- 3 Electrical sockets used by entertainers shall be fitted with residual current device protection (complying with BS 7671; Requirements for Electrical Installations) and labeled accordingly
- 4 All children on the premises must be accompanied by an adult
