1.0 **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** : Andrew Parker

2.0 **DECLARATION OF INTERESTS**: CD declared an interest in the Roewood Lodge planning application.

3.0 QUESTIONS/STATEMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

A resident expressed concern that there had been three recent incidents of children absconding from the Castle Care Children's Home. He had assisted the Police the previous weekend. Another resident has submitted a formal complaint to Castle Care and advised the PC and asked for this to be documented. TT advised that it was a Children's Home and not a secure unit. 4.0 PLANNING

4.1 REF:15/01890/FUL Conversion to dwelling and rear extensions (Revised Scheme of Planning Permission 14/01262/FUL). Plot 2 Coach and Horses Public House, Nottingham Rd, Thurgarton. TT and CD had met with the developer to look at the application. TT had initially been concerned about flood risk but was now happy with the application. TT proposed 'Acceptance' and this was seconded by CD and agreed unanimously.

4.2 REF:16/00398/FUL Demolition of existing dwelling and erect four small two bedroom bungalows, including new vehicular access. White Lodge, Bleasby Rd, Thurgarton, Notts. An extension had been agreed until 20th April. The developer had expressed an interest to attend the meeting on the 19th. It was agreed to defer the item until then.

4.3 REF: 15/02291/FUL Construction of new two storey dwelling and garage (resubmission of 15/00438/FUL) Roewood Lodge, Bleasby Rd, Thurgarton, Notts. CD felt that the plans lacked detail and that more information was needed in order to make a decision. TT proposed and it was agreed that more information should be sought from the District Council.

5.0 **APPLICATION FOR A MINOR VARIATION TO A PREMISES LICENSE** or club premises certificate under the Licensing Act 2003 – Thurgarton Village Hall.
