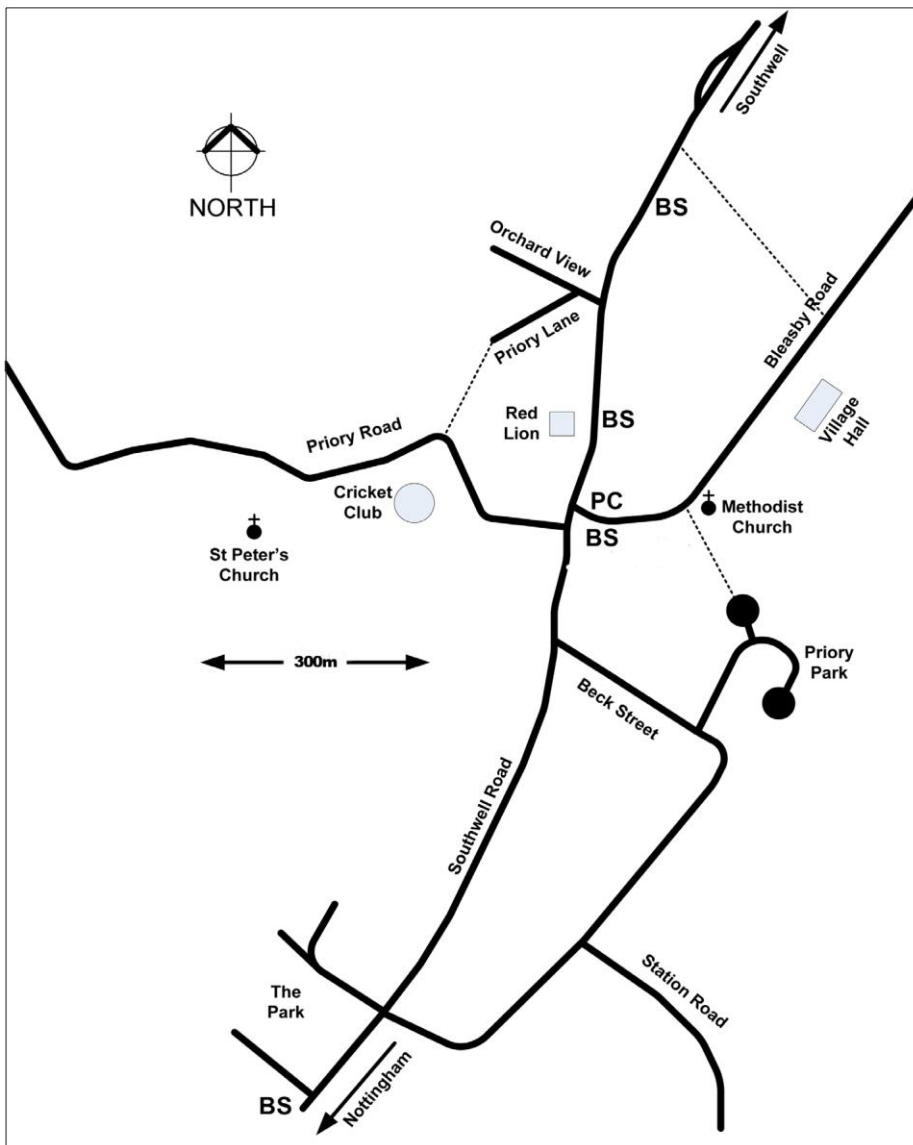


Welcome to Thurgarton Village

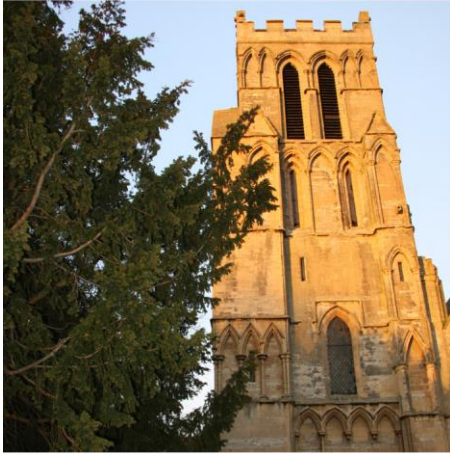
