Minutes of the Council Meeting held on 14th June 2018 at 7.30 pm in the Village Hall

1. Apologies

All members being present, there were no apologies.

2. Declaration of Interests

No interests were declared.

Coun. . Aston agreed to produce the minutes of the meeting.

3. Minutes of the previous meetings

The Minutes of the meeting held on 8th May 2018 were not available and approval was deferred to the next meeting.

4. Planning

18/00828/FUL – Hill Top Cottage, Priory Lane

Householder application to construct a single storey extension. The Council unanimously supported the application.

18/00761/FUL – Woodside Farm, Nottingham Road

Erection of a steel framed building to house cattle.

Concern was expressed at the possibility of slurry running off the hilltop site into the drainage dyke or into adjacent properties. The applicant gave assurances that there would be no slurry.

The Council supported the application, 6 in favour and one abstention with the proviso that a condition should be made whereby the structure is demolished at the end of its useful life..

18/00967/FUL – The Red Lion, Southwell Road

Application to vary condition 02 attached to planning application 16/00965/FUL to amend the plans for plots 1 and 2 and the cart shed elevations.

The Council unanimously supported the application.

Although 6 of the 7 councillors are potential investors in this public house venture, no declarations were declared upon the Chairman stating that the Clerk had indicated that it was not necessary for this project.

18/00934/FUL – Appleacre, Bleasby Road

Householder application for rear extension and first floor dormer extensions to create dormer bungalow and the erection of a retaining wall.

The Council unanimously supported the application.

18/00905/FUL – Charnwood, Bleasby Road

Householder application to form a new entrance into the property.

The Council unanimously supported the application.
